Engineered Stone Care and Maintenance

Routine Care

Engineered Stone can be cleaned with damp cloth or a mild soap. It does not require any special cleaners.

Stains or Dried Spills

Any multi-purpose cleaner or detergent can be used on stains. For dried spills, use a green scouring pad.

Heat Resistance

Hot pots and pans should NOT be placed directly on Engineered Stone. Although the brand is touted as heat resistant, it can burn if exposed to very hot items.

Chemical Reactions

Engineered Stone can be permanently damaged by exposure to strong chemicals and solvents which undermine its physical properties. Do not use any products that contain trichlorethane or methylene chloride, such as paint removers or strippers. Avoid any highly aggressive cleaning agents like oven/grill cleaner that have high alkaline/pH levels. Should any of these chemicals come in contact with Engineered Stone, rinse immediately with water to neutralize the effect.
